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## Online DIBELS Training Goes Live in February 2009

DMG is pleased and excited to announce the launch of online DIBELS training. You can now get high quality training from the DIBELS authors, Roland Good and Ruth Kaminski, in the comfort of your own classroom. The training is a taped version of the annual Eugene Institute that has been edited into a form suitable for online viewing. Use the online training to supplement your on-site training conducted by DMG staff or a DMG trained DIBELS

Mentor. Any school or district planning to use DIBELS in a Response to Intervention model will need to have all teachers trained to administer and score the measures in order to progress monitor students who are receiving reading interventions. Online training highlights include:

- Access to the training videos 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, for 21 days
- Ability to pause, rewind, or replay material
- All DIBELS measures presented in individual video modules, allowing participants to choose the modules they wish to watch and choose the order in which they are watched
- Training handouts provided for each module
- An introductory rate for one viewer (one subscription) of \$75.00
- Reduced rates for 5 or more subscriptions from the same school or district

Single subscribers will soon be able to register and pay online directly on our website—announcement coming soon. Orders for groups of 5 or more from the same school or district are now being taken for access in February, March, and April. Call 541-431-6931 and ask for details.
