

The Acadience Reading Survey materials are a separate set of Acadience Reading K–6 forms in one testing book, designed for use in testing students in successively lower levels of materials until their instructional and progress monitoring levels are found.

The assessment is used with students who have missed prior benchmark goals and continue to struggle in acquiring basic early literacy skills. It may also be used with students who score in the strategic or intensive range during benchmark assessment as a way to get more information for instructional planning and goal setting.

Acadience Reading Survey includes guidelines for setting goals, monitoring progress, and making instructional decisions. It is designed as a companion tool for use with Acadience Reading K–6 and Acadience Reading 7–8.

Acadience Reading Survey is a powerful tool for educators because it:

- helps educators determine the optimal progress monitoring level for students who are below benchmark
- helps educators set appropriate and ambitious goals that lead to accelerated student performance
